Happy 50th Anniversary to YCSWA! The Authority celebrated 50 years of serving York County in December. To commemorate our 50th anniversary and celebrate receiving the Governor's Award for Environmental Excellence, the Authority hosted the county commissioners and Sen. Phillips-Hill to recognize this milestone and state award. The commissioners and the senator presented the Authority with citations celebrating both of these achievements.

Since receiving the Articles of Incorporation from the state on December 28, 1971, the Authority has established one of the top municipal solid waste authorities in the state and has successfully managed 15,165,252 tons of waste through November 2021 with an eye toward preserving the environment.

Christmas Tree Recycling

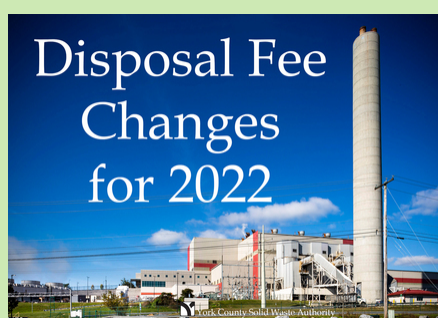

recycle them into mulch. Visit the link below for more details.

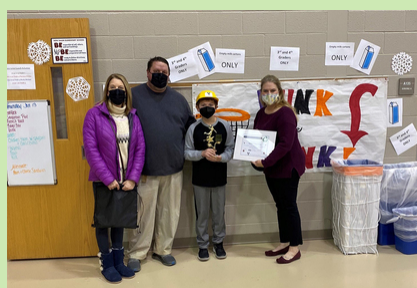

Tip Fee Change

The tip fee (cost for disposal) for York County processible municipal solid waste at the York County Resource Recovery Center (YCRRC) for 2022 will increase from \$67.50 per ton to \$70 per ton. This increase represents a 3.7 percent increase. The minimum fee to dispose of waste will remain at \$20 for up to 560 pounds.
