Wish Cycling is when you place something in your recycling bin that you wish could be recycled but aren't certain it really is recyclable. Although the thought behind Wish Cycling is nice, we do not recommend that you do it. Only place those things in your recycling bin that you know can be



recycled. Contaminants found in your recycling bin will be hand-sorted from recyclables at the recycling facility and the facility will pay to dispose of them as trash.

## **Electronics Recycling**

YAY, York County! You are doing a great job of recycling electronics. As a matter of fact, in 2020 a total of 906.3 tons of electronics were recycled through

In Pennsylvania certain

electronics are restricted by law

from being disposed of in the trash due to the toxic metals they contain. The Covered Device Recycling Act (CDRA), Act 108 of 2010, requires the following "covered devices" to be recycled in Pennsylvania:

-Computers

-Computer Peripherals (keyboard, mouse, printer, etc.)

-Computer Monitors

-Televisions

Do you have any of these items that need to be disposed of? If so, bring them to our Electronics Recycling Drop-Off Center located at the York County Resource Recovery Center. For a more complete list of accepted items or other information about electronics recycling click here.



#### YCSWA Recycle Drop-Off Center

The Authority's public Recycle Drop-Off Center is open for York County residents and commercial entities Monday through Friday from 8AM to 4PM and Saturday from 8AM to noon. There is no fee to deliver recyclables to the center which can be accessed via Blackgum Court.

#### Accepted Items

Metal (rinse thoroughly; it is not necessary to remove labels):

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Steel and bi-metal food & beverage cans
- Corrugated Cardboard (dry and flattened):
- All sizes of corrugated cardboard boxes

Clothing and Shoes:

• Clean clothing and shoes are accepted in the Salvation Army drop-off bin
