# MUNICIPAL WASTE COLLECTION AND TRANSPORTATION REGISTRATION STANDARDS FOR PART III OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

## WATER TREATMENT SLUDGE AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT SLUDGE

All capitalized terms used herein, unless otherwise indicated, shall-have the meaning specified in the Definitions section of the Municipal Waste Collection and Transportation Registration Rules and Regulations.

#### A. REGSTRATION AND DECALS

- 1. Vehicles must display a valid permanently affixed Registration decal on the driver's side door where it is visible. If a semi-tractor(s) is owned by the Registrant other than the owner of the trailer(s), the semi-tractor need not display a decal if (i) the tractor displays a decal and is issued to the owner of the trailer; and (ii) the semi-tractor displays a Public Utility Commission (PUC) Number or an Interstate Commerce Commission (ICC) Number and the owner of the semi-tractor reported such numbers to the Authority on its Registration application.
- 2. A Registration decal may not be transferred from the vehicle to which it was originally issued.

## B. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Vehicles must be maintained by the Registrant to prevent leakage of waste.
- 2. Registrant must dispose of Water Treatment Sludge and/or Wastewater Treatment Sludge only at Designated Disposal Sites. The Designated Disposal Sites include any wastewater treatment facilities, land application disposal sites or any other permitted disposal or processing facilities permitted by the Commonwealth to treat, receive and/or dispose of Water Treatment Sludge and/or Wastewater Treatment Sludge.
- 3. Registrant shall comply with all applicable Designated Disposal Site operational procedures and guidelines.

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#### C. MANIFEST REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Registrant shall be responsible for manifesting each transaction of sludge generated in York County and transactions of sludge to be managed in York County for disposal or beneficial use, regardless of point of generation.
- 2. Registrant shall be responsible for delivery of manifest copies to the following two parties at the time of the transaction: the generator and the disposal facility. The yellow copy of the manifest must be delivered to the York County Solid Waste Authority within one month after a transaction.
- 3. Registrant must account for each numbered manifest.
- 4. Registrant shall notify the Authority when additional manifest books are needed. Allow two weeks for delivery of additional books.
- 5. An option to substitute a monthly report in lieu of manifesting each transaction may be granted on a case-by-case basis at the sole discretion of the YCSWA. The report shall be submitted to the YCSWA by the generator and contain the following information: The disposal site permit number; farm name and field ID where biosolids were applied; total permitted field acres; actual acres used; agronomic loading rate(dry tons per acre); the time period (month) when biosolids were applied to each field; the volume applied to each field, reported in dry tons; the source of the sludge (i.e. name of treatment plant); and the name of the hauling company.

#### D. DESIGNATED DISPOSAL SITES:

All Water Treatment Sludge and/or Wastewater Treatment Sludge shall only be delivered to any wastewater treatment facilities, land application disposal sites or any other disposal or processing facilities permitted by the Commonwealth or any other jurisdiction to treat, receive and/or dispose of such Water Treatment Sludge and/or Wastewater Treatment Sludge.
