# MUNICIPAL WASTE COLLECTION AND TRANSPORTATION REGISTRATION STANDARDS FOR PART IV OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

### MEDICAL WASTE

All capitalized terms used herein, unless otherwise indicated, shall-have the meaning specified in the Definitions section of the Municipal Waste Collection and Transportation Registration Rules and Regulations.

### A. REGESTRATION

Vehicles must display a valid Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) Infectious Chemotherapeutic Waste Transporters License Number on both sides and on the rear of the vehicle as required by the PADEP.

## B. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Vehicles must be maintained by the Registrant to prevent any loss of waste.
- 2. The Registrant shall dispose of Infectious Chemotherapeutic Waste only at Designated Disposal Sites, which include facilities permitted by the Commonwealth or other appropriate jurisdiction to treat, receive and/or dispose of such Medical Waste.
- 3. Registrant shall comply with all applicable Designated Disposal Site operational procedures and guidelines.

## C. REPORTS

The Registrant must submit to the Authority by March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year a photocopy of the annual PADEP report which is required by Transporters of Infectious Chemotherapeutic Waste.

#### D. DESIGNATED DISPOSAL SITES:

The Registrant shall dispose of Medical Waste only at Designated Disposal Sites which include facilities permitted by the Commonwealth or any other jurisdiction to treat, receive and/or dispose of such Medical Waste.
